










Shareholder perceptions



2017 - Reaction to Grenfell

- Water
- Not asked for, didn't know where to deliver it, traumatised colleagues.
 - Better liaison with Local Authority
- Mobile phones
- No control, fraudulent claims.
 - Centralised co-ordination of what we're doing
- Biggest issue for colleagues in London
- Tesco largely unaffected
 - Closer link between local and central leadership
- Charity Partnership
- Ready to provide aid abroad, not to the UK.
 - Building links with British Red Cross.
